

ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST CATHOLIC CHURCH



Located in Warrenton Virginia, St John the Evangelist Catholic Church was first established in 1874. The Gothic Style stone church was dedicated in 1965 at its current site on Winchester Street. In 2000, Carson Ashley and Associates with Robert Loveless Architects prepared plans for a two story addition for the expansion of the sanctuary from 500 seats to 1000 seats. Shortly after the plan was approved the Arlington Diocese declared a moratorium on all new building projects within the Diocese. In 2005 planning for the expansion began again but due to the rising building costs a simpler one story expansion was designed. The new design added two wing additions to the sanctuary, if seen from the air it is shaped like an angel. Our work included additional landscaping and parking.
